The Lacombe Museums are reopening July 2020

We are happy to announce that the Michener House Museum & Archives is set to open July 2nd, and provide the community an opportunity to safely engage with the history of Lacombe. Likewise the Lacombe Blacksmith Shop Museum will be opening July 16th.

Reopening the museum means that tours will be reintroduced at The Michener House Museum this week.

Tours of the Michener House can be remotely booked online at lacombemuseum.com or by calling in. We will offer tours on Tuesdays, Thursdays and Saturdays from 1:00pm – 4:00pm - the website will show a live feed of the available timeslots to book tours.

The tour will allow visitors to see the historic Michener House and all of the artifacts on display. The tour will be conducted by a Historical Interpreter that will provide a guided tour through the museum

To ensure safety to all visitors and staff members during the tours, we have implemented some guidelines.

- Limit of 6 guests in the Michener House at a time. 10 guest limit at the Blacksmith Shop Museum.
- Visitors will be asked to wear masks. If you do not have a mask we can provide you with a disposable one.
- Social distancing measures will be in effect. Maintain a distance of 2 meters from staff and other guests.

Along with those measure we also have hand sanitization stations that can be found throughout the museum for visitor use. We will be ensuring to sanitize high traffic areas and touch points.

Walk-in research requests are currently not allowed. If you do have a request, feel free to call or email your inquiry. Walk-Donations are also currently not allowed. If you have an artifact you would like to donate, you may call or email to arrange any such donation.
